

2026 Admission Fee Exemption (Deferred Payment) and Tuition Fee Exemption [Graduate Students]

○2026 Admission Fee Exemption and Admission Fee Deferred Payment

1. Eligibility

Those who fall under any of the following are eligible. For Privately-Financed International Students, the situation in Japan is applicable, and the situation in their home country does not qualify for application.

- 1) Students who have difficulty in paying their Admission Fee for financial reasons (excluding loan repayment or other debt), and who are moreover recognized as excellent academic achievers.
- 2) Students who face extreme difficulty in paying their Admission Fee because their household supporter passed away within one year before enrollment, or students who themselves and/or their household supporters have suffered from a natural disaster, such as a storm or flood, within one year before enrollment.
- 3) Household supporters or students who have been affected by the following catastrophic disaster.
The catastrophic disaster: Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024
- 4) Cases equivalent to the above, and approved by the President.

*Please note that Admission Fees paid before the application for Admission Fee Exemption/Deferred Payment and before notification of the result of the application are non-refundable.

2. Amount of Admission Fee Exemption

Those who are approved exemption will be exempted from paying the full or half amount of the Admission Fee.

However, Graduate Students have only been approved half exemption in recent years.

Applicants who are approved a half exemption, or not approved, must transfer the Admission Fee within 20 days, including the date of notification.

3. Admission Fee Deferred Payment

Payment will be deferred until the end of September. It does not mean an exemption. The Admission Fee must be transferred without fail by the last day of September.

4. Admission Fee Exemption and Deferred Payment

It is possible to simultaneously apply for both Admission Fee Exemption and Deferred Payment by submitting a complete set of application forms. In the case of a combined application for Admission Fee Exemption and Deferred Payment, if a half exemption is approved or if the application for exemption is not approved, payment of the Admission Fee can still be deferred until the last day of September, provided that the application for Deferred Payment is accepted.

5. Submitted Documents

6. Acceptance of Documents for Submission

[Deadline] Monday, March 16, 2026 (postmark valid on the day of the deadline; by mail only).

7. Flow After Admission

Those who apply for the Admission Fee Exemption and Deferred Payment must apply for the Tuition Fee Exemption too.

If the application for Admission Fee Exemption has been completed but the application for Tuition Fee Exemption has not been completed, the results of both applications will be "not approved".

After enrollment, please complete the procedure for Tuition Fee Exemption application through the "Tuition Fee Exemption Student Application System". (Hereinafter the "Exemption System")

If you submit the required documents displayed on the screen, the procedure will be completed.

For information about the Exemption System, please refer to "11. Using the Tuition Fee Exemption Student Application System" on the next page.

8. Notification of Results

Notification of results will be made around mid-July in the "Messages For You" section of the "Educational Affairs System", which will become available after enrollment.

9. Other

Once an application for exemption or deferred payment has been received, payment of the Admission Fee is effectively deferred until the results of the application are announced.

Applicants who are approved a half exemption, or not approved, must transfer the outstanding Admission Fee **within 20 days, including the date of notification.** Students who don't pay the Admission Fee will be removed from the register.

However, if these students also applied for deferred payment and received approval, payment is effectively deferred until the end of September. (If no payment is received by the end of September, **the student will be removed from the register.**)

○2026 Tuition Fee Exemption

Those who are approved exemption will be exempted from paying the full or half amount of the Tuition Fee. In principle, Tuition Fee Exemption application is once a year, for both Spring and Fall semester, instead of each semester. Although application is for the entire year, the selection is made twice a year. The results may differ for Spring and Fall semesters.

1 0. Eligibility

Those who fall under any of the following are eligible. For Privately-Financed International Students, the situation in Japan is applicable, and the situation in their home country does not qualify for application.

- 1) Students who face difficulty in paying their Tuition Fee due to economic reasons (excluding loan repayment or other debt) and are recognized as having excellent academic achievements.
- 2) Students who face extreme difficulty in paying their tuition fee because their household supporter passed away within one year before enrollment, or students who themselves and/or their household supporters have suffered from a natural disaster, such as a storm or flood, within one year before enrollment.
- 3) Household supporters or students who have been affected by the following catastrophic disaster.
The catastrophic disaster: Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024
- 4) Cases equivalent to the above, and approved by the President.

1 1. Using the Tuition Fee Exemption Student Application System (Hereinafter the “Exemption System”)

The application process for Tuition Fee Exemption is completed through the “Exemption System” and is completed by submitting the required documents displayed in the system.

Please complete the procedures during the system availability period and submit the documents by the deadline described in "13. Acceptance of Submitted Documents".

Exemption System Application Period : Monday, April 13th - Wednesday, April 22nd, noon (JST)

- * Applications will not be accepted after the Exemption System availability period.
 - * Exemption System is accessible through [the Tuition and Admission Fee Exemption SharePoint page](#), which will become available after enrollment.
 - * Documents issued by government offices are required, so please apply as soon as possible regardless of the application period.
 - * To log in to the system and SharePoint site, you must enter your THERS account and THERS account password. You can confirm your THERS account online beginning Saturday, March 28th. After completing your “THERS Account Set-Up” and "Information Security Training for New Students", please log-in to the system after Monday, April 13th.
- If you are entering from a Nagoya University undergraduate or graduate school, your THERS account will remain unchanged.

1 2. Submitted Documents

Please check the required documents displayed when you complete the Exemption System entry and submit the necessary documents. Please print out the required sheets from the "Exemption Application Print" page of the system.

1 3. Acceptance of Submitted Documents

In principle, documents should be submitted **at the submission site on the date and time reserved** through the Exemption System.

If you are unable to submit the documents at the submission site listed below, please submit them at the **Student Support Division counter (reservations not possible)** or send them by **postal mail (acceptance-recorded mail or Letter Pack Light, etc., which will keep a record.)** by the deadline.

[Deadline] Thursday, April 23rd, 2026 [MUST ARRIVE BY THIS DATE]

- ① Please make a reservation for a date and time for document submission by clicking “Appointment for Document Submission” in the Exemption System. The dates of the submission site are as follows.

- ② Please submit the application documents at the submission site on the reserved date and time. Please kindly note that documents cannot be accepted at the Student Support Division counter while the submission site is available.

1 4. Notification of Results

Notification of results will be made in the “Messages For You” section of the “Educational Affairs System” which will become available after enrollment. *For Spring semester : Early August / For Fall semester : Middle of December

1 5. Other

Once an application for exemption has been received, payment of the Tuition Fee is effectively deferred until the results of the application are announced. For those who are not exempted in full, the Tuition Fee will be deducted from the bank account you registered for tuition on the date to be announced in the result notification.
